Stanley G. Chapman, III serves as Executive Vice-President and Chief Operating Officer, Natural Gas Pipelines. In this role he is responsible for all regulatory, commercial and operational matters across TC Energy's natural gas transmission and storage businesses in the United States, Canada, and Mexico. Prior to that, he served as Executive Vice-President and Group Executive, U.S. and Mexico Natural Gas Pipelines.

Prior to its merger with TC Energy in March 2021, Mr. Chapman also served as Chairman of the General Partner for TC PipeLines GP, Inc., a master limited partnership, effective January 1, 2019.

Before joining TC Energy in July 2016 as part of the Columbia Pipeline Group (CPG) acquisition, Mr. Chapman served as Columbia's Executive Vice-President and Chief Commercial Officer and as the President of Columbia Pipeline Partners, LP, a master limited partnership. Previous to joining CPG in December 2011, Mr. Chapman held various positions of increasing responsibility with El Paso Corp and Tenneco Energy and was responsible for various marketing and commercial operations, as well as supply, regulatory, business development and optimization activities.

Mr. Chapman is past Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America, a current Board member of the American Gas Association, a current member and past executive committee member of the Society of Gas Lighters, and a current member of the International Association for Energy Economics. Mr. Chapman holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics from Texas A&M University as well as a Master of Business Administration degree with a specialization in Finance from the University of St. Thomas. He resides in Houston, Texas where he and his wife raised their four children.
