The Canada Energy Regulator (CER) has received an application from NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL), pursuant to section 183 of the *Canadian Energy Regulator Act* (CER Act), for approval to construct and operate new pipeline facilities, which would be part of the existing NGTL System in Alberta. These facilities are referred to as the West Path Delivery 2023 Project (Project), consisting of:

NGTL reserved the right to amend its Application to seek an exemption order under section 214 of the CER Act to construct and operate the Project should the pipeline length be less than 40 kilometres after design has progressed.
