Prior to Enable, Mrs. Faraca worked with Enbridge, and its predecessor Spectra Energy, in multiple leadership positions over the course of 18 years including Vice-President of Engineering and Construction, Vice-President of Corporate Strategy and President of Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline.

Mrs. Faraca currently serves on the Board of Trustees for the United Way of Greater Houston and is a member of the Board of Directors of GTI Energy and the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America (INGAA).
