

# PROJECT ELEMENT: CARBON CAPTURE AND SEQUESTRATION

# **PRAIRIE HORIZON ENERGY SOLUTIONS –**

a collaboration between Marathon Petroleum Corporation and TC Energy – is a potential low-carbon energy project in Stark County, North Dakota. The project includes a low-carbon hydrogen and ammonia production facility, a carbon dioxide  $(CO_2)$  pipeline and carbon capture and sequestration (CCS) operations.

## **CARBON CAPTURE**

filters and collects more than 90% of  $CO_2$  from the Production Facility's emission stream instead of releasing it to the atmosphere.

### **SEQUESTRATION**

permanent geological storage of the  $CO_2$  deep underground – more than a mile below the earth's surface and well below the area's water table – minimizing impacts to our air, water and land.



# **SEISMIC SURVEY**

- Conducted early in the CCS evaluation phase.
- Provides information to evaluate rock layers and further analyze the potential CO<sub>2</sub> storage location.
- Common survey used in the energy industry; surveys have been performed in every county in western ND.



#### PROCESS

- Truck-mounted device generates vibrations using a metal plate that lies on the ground and shakes from side-to-side.
- Vibrations travel deep into the earth and are reflected back.
- Surface sensors record the reflected vibrations.
- Geophysics analyze the results to better define potential CO<sub>2</sub> storage formations.
