Project: 2021 Meter Stations and Laterals Abandonment Program

In December 2021, NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL), an affiliate of TC Energy Corporation (TC Energy), sent you notification of NGTL's proposal to permanently cease operations at 10-meter station and their associated lateral pipelines, four stand-alone meter stations, and two stand-alone lateral pipelines (the Facilities) as these Facilities are no longer required to service customers. In addition, in February 2022, NGTL sent an update to the application filing schedule and proposed schedule for abandonment activities. The Program is an annual program taking place across Alberta.

As required by its regulator, the Canada Energy Regulator (CER), in May 2022, NGTL sent notice that the 2021 Abandonment Program application was filed on May 3, 2022 and included a link to the CER's Document Library and the Program's external website.

NGTL now wishes to advise that on August 9, 2022, it filed an update to the 2021 Abandonment Program application, with the CER. The update can be found on the CER's Document Library at: <https://apps/cer-rec/gc/ca/REGDOCS/Item/View/4257482> (CER Filing ID: C20437).
