- In January 2022, NGTL sent you notification of NGTL's proposal to permanently cease operations at 21 lateral pipelines and three associated meter stations (the Facilities) as these Facilities are no longer required to service customers.
- In April 2023, some of you may have received further updates on changes to the Facilities listed for decommissioning, with the addition of the NPS Ralston Lateral.
- NGTL wishes to advise that the NPS 4 and NPS 6 Stanmore South Laterals and Burnt Timber Sales Meter Station, have been removed from the Program.

As required by its regulator, the Canada Energy Regulator (CER), we are writing to advise you that the 2022 Decommissioning Program application was filed on August 22, 2023.
