RE: 2026 Pipelines and Associated Facilities Decommissioning Program (2026 Decommissioning Program) – CER Application Notification

In February 2026, NGTL GP Ltd., as general partner on behalf of NGTL Limited Partnership (collectively NGTL), both indirect wholly owned subsidiaries of TC Energy, sent you notification of NGTL's proposal to permanently cease operations of 11 lateral pipelines or loops and one co-located meter station on the NGTL System within Alberta (collectively, the Facilities), as these Facilities are no longer required to provide service to customers. The 2026 Decommissioning Program is an annual program taking place across Alberta.

As required by the regulator, the Canada Energy Regulator (CER), we are writing to advise you that the 2026 Decommissioning Program application was filed on May 25, 2026. 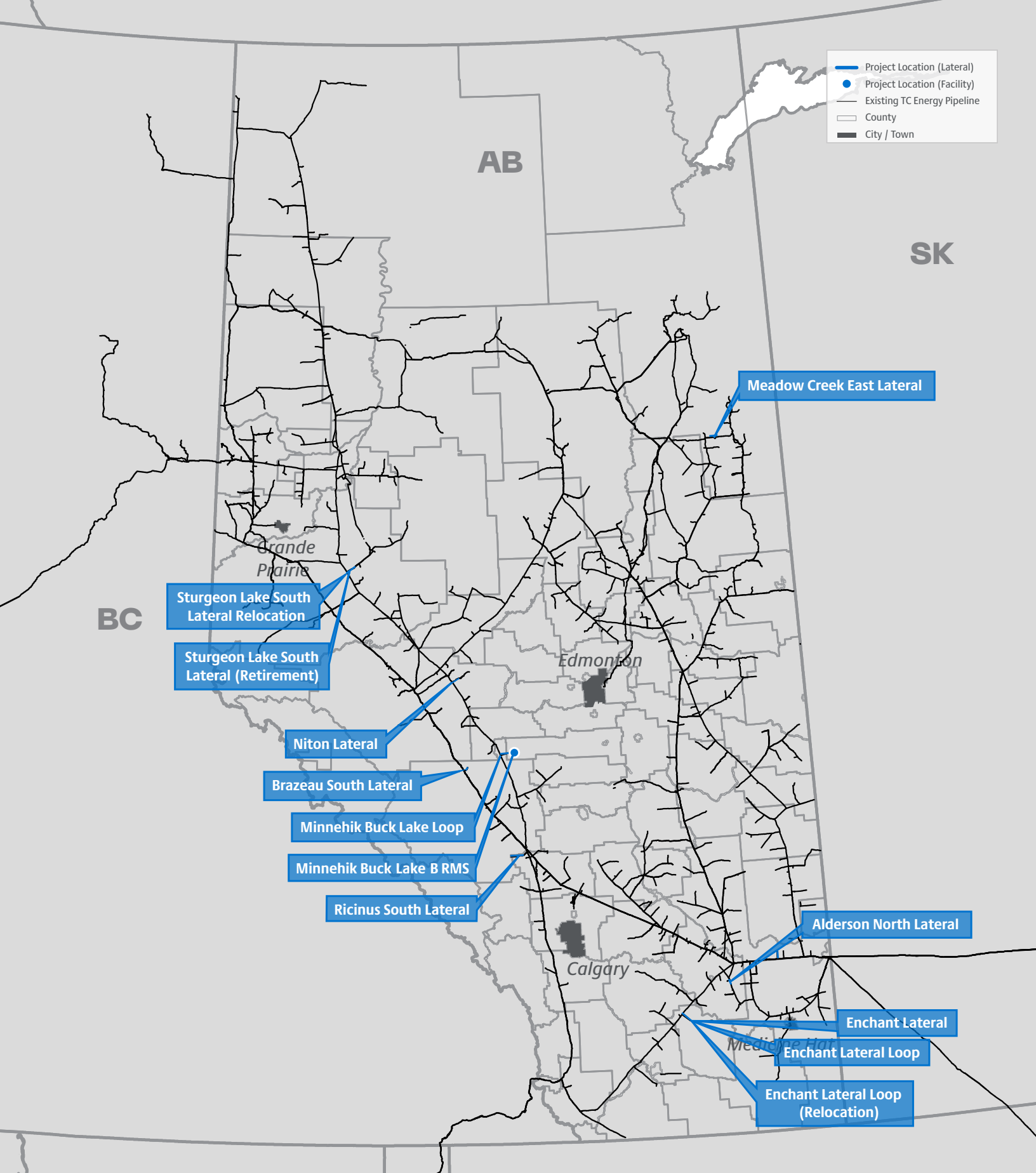
