# EAST LATERAL XPRESS (ELXP) PROJECT

The East Lateral XPress (ELXP) project will provide 725 MDth/d of firm natural gas transportation service on TC Energy's Columbia Gulf Transmission (CGT) East Lateral Pipeline system to a new delivery point in Plaquemines Parish, La., where the gas will then be routed to Venture Global Plaquemines' Liquified Natural Gas (LNG) terminal.

ELXP will create 183 MDth/d of incremental capacity. This incremental capacity, along with the utilization of existing capacity on CGT's system, will allow for the full project capacity consisting of 575 MDth/d from CGT's onshore pool in Rayne, La., and 150 MDth/d from a CGT meter station in Venice, La. The new delivery point in Plaquemines Parish will feed Venture Global's Gator Express Pipeline for subsequent delivery to the Plaquemines LNG terminal.

## The project scope includes:

- Two new compressor stations, with one (Centerville) in St. Mary's Parish, La., and the other (Golden Meadow) in Lafourche Parish, La.
- One new 30-in. lateral pipeline in Plaquemines and Jefferson Parishes, La., that will extend about 8.1 miles from CGT's East Lateral EL-300 to a new point-of-delivery meter station.
- One pipeline tie-in platform in Jefferson Parish.

TC Energy and its contractors are taking careful measures during the engineering, design and construction phases to ensure Louisiana's coastal wetlands remain protected. This includes building compressor stations on platforms given shallow-water floodplain considerations.

# **Project schedule**

Project construction anticipated in 2024 with 2025 in-service delivery. These dates are subject to change until the project plan is finalized.
