NGTL GP Ltd. (NGTL GP), as general partner on behalf of NGTL Limited Partnership, both indirectly wholly owned subsidiaries of TC Energy, is in the process of developing for a natural gas pipeline expansion project in northern Alberta on its NGTL System to support the transportation of natural gas to growing domestic markets in Alberta. The Leming Lake Sales Lateral Loop (Field Lake Section) Project (“Project”) is necessary to increase natural gas transportation to meet growing demand. NGTL GP filed an application with the Canada Energy Regulator (CER) under Section 214 of the Canadian Energy Regulator Act in Q1 2024, with a commercial in-service date in Q2 2026.

NPS 20 Field Lake Section

The Field Lake Section consists of approximately 17 kilometers (km) of 20-inch diameter (NPS 20) pipeline originating at the Field Lake Compressor Station approximately 8 km east of Lac La Biche, AB at NE-6-67-12-W4M, and ending at a valve site at SW-8-66-11-W4M within Lac La Biche County.
