

Line A-159 Extension Project

Project Fact Sheet

Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (“Columbia”) proposes to extend a portion of Line A-159 in Ohio to reconfigure gas flow and maximize system delivery capability to central Ohio markets.

The current configuration of TCO Lines A-79 and A-159 creates a drop in pressure between the Mount Sterling Regulator Station and the start of Line A-159. This limits Columbia’s ability to maximize delivery capability. By reconfiguring the pipeline system to extend A-159 by an additional 3.25 miles of new 24-inch diameter pipeline west of Mount Sterling in Madison County, the existing pressure drop will be eliminated, and the system delivery capability on Columbia’s system will be optimized.

Additionally, the following modifications in Madison and Greene counties will be performed:

- Replacement of approximately 20 feet of existing 20-inch diameter pipeline;
- Replacement of one existing mainline valve (MLV) and two elbows at separate locations along existing Line A-159; and
- Installation of new aboveground bi-directional launcher/receiver settings and associated piping at the existing Mount Sterling Regulator Station (RS) and Howell RS.

These existing pipelines provide safe and reliable transportation service to markets in central Ohio. The modifications will ensure that communities in the region receive the energy they need to power schools, homes and other public services.

The project is expected to begin construction in March 2022 with a projected in-service date of September 2022.
