

North Baja XPress Project

The North Baja XPress (NBX) Project is designed to expand capacity on the North Baja Pipeline by upgrading one existing compressor station and two existing meter stations in Arizona and California. All the upgrades will occur on property and within facilities.

The facilities and associated work:

- The Ehrenberg Compressor Station and the El Paso Meter Station in La Paz County, Arizona, will be upgraded with a new compressor unit and a new natural gas measurement system.
- The Ogilby Meter Station in Imperial County, California, will also receive a new gas measurement system.

The NBX Project will leverage existing infrastructure to meet a growing demand for natural gas by expanding capacity on the North Baja Pipeline, which supplies gas to Arizona, California and Mexico. Throughout all stages of this project, we will continue to develop and maintain relationships with landowners and local communities and, during construction, we will seek to hire local workers when possible.
