François Poirier is the President and Chief Executive Officer of TC Energy, a leading North American energy infrastructure company working to solve today's most complex energy challenges.

Throughout more than three decades in the energy business, François has demonstrated a unique blend of steady leadership and strategic vision. He joined TC Energy in 2014 as President of Energy East and made an immediate impact by successfully executing the acquisition of the Columbia Pipeline group, a U.S.-based company. François was named the company's Chief Operating Officer and President of the Power & Storage and Mexico business units before becoming President and CEO in 2021.

François believes that North America has a historic opportunity to form a partnership to deliver cleaner, affordable and more reliable energy at home and around the world. He secured a first-of-its-kind strategic partnership in Mexico that is enabling the development of critical energy infrastructure to meet the country's growing demand while reducing emissions.

Under his leadership, TC Energy has also expanded its portfolio of new energy solutions—including the development of carbon capture and hydrogen technology in the U.S. and Canada—and has established itself as a key part of the solution for expanding access to North American liquefied natural gas (LNG) in response to the global energy crisis.

Prior to joining TC Energy, François spent 25 years in investment banking, consulting and as a corporate director. He served as a president and head of Investment Banking and Capital Markets at Wells Fargo Securities Canada, Ltd. and prior to that, he led the Power and Pipelines Investment Banking division at J.P. Morgan Securities and served as the Independent Director of Capital Power Income LP.

François is a long-time triathlete and dedicated advocate for mental health, establishing TC Energy's Mental Health Champions Network. He is currently co-chairing the host committee for the Special Olympics Canada Winter Games to be held in Calgary, Alberta, in 2024.
