TC Energy — Winter Pre-trip Checklist

0	Check weather conditions	Review the current and future weather forecast for your destination and the areas that you will be travelling through.	
0	Plan your route	Enter your destination and plan your route ahead of time using your mobile device or GPS unit.	
_	Check road conditions	Review <u>road conditions</u> to ensure driving conditions are acceptable and take note of posted road closures, weather delays or closures and construction along your route.	
_	Check tires	Install winter tires, if needed. Check condition and air pressure, plus ensure your spare tire is properly inflated.	
_	Check fuel	Ensure that you start your trip with a <u>full tank of gas</u> and, if needed, top it up during your travels. Try to not let it drop below half a tank.	
_	Check vehicle fluids	Ensure you check and top up other vehicle fluids, such as oil, windshield washer fluid (-40), and radiator antifreeze overflow reservoir, etc.	
	Check if safety kit is in vehicle	Ensure your <u>safety kit</u> is packed in your vehicle and easily accessible in case you need it.	SOA
	Charge your cellphone	Ensure you have a fully charged cellphone, plus a car charger cable and recommended battery booster pack.	
	Snow brush and scraper in vehicle	Ensure you have a snow brush and scraper in the vehicle.	
_	Clean your windows and mirrors	Ensure your windows (inside and out) and mirrors are clean for maximum visibility.	
	Clean and test your lights	Ensure your vehicle headlights, front and rear signal lights are clean and working; test signal lights and brake lights.	
	Clean snow/ice off vehicle	Ensure you clear snow from entire vehicle and scrape ice from windows, mirrors and lights.	
	Traction aids in vehicle	Consider carrying traction aids, such as sand or traction tracks, in vehicle when travelling in snowy areas.
